## Work is progressing well –

See the photographs at the back of church. We hope to arrange a visit inside in the next couple of weeks

- They are digging deeper to find solid clay.
- Dry rot has been found, we hope it has not affected the pews
- 4 small skull fragments found so far but this does not stop work.
- More memorial stones found under the floor in the organ loft.
- Evidence of tree roots in the south transept.
- Wood work in the baptistery and under the gallery has been removed.
- The church building is now closed to everyone as it is a building site.

  It would be appreciated if all Church keys could be handed to the Church Wardens as soon as possible.

  Keys for the new locks will be issued when the work has been completed.
