† **Income Survey** – Every **October** we have to carry out an income survey of the congregation. The information is used to set our **Parish Share** (*i.e. the amount of money we pay to fund mission and clergy*) for the coming year. **It is very important that the information provided is as accurate as possible.**

If you aren't sure please take it home and check your income figures before completing the form and handing it back in.

Please be assured the form doesn't ask for any personal details so nobody will know who has filled it in.

So if you haven't already filled a form in already we will be asking you complete it by ticking a box on the Income form.

- Only fill the form in if you attend Church more than **12 times a year**.
- Only fill the form in **once** during October.
- Tick the "band" on the form that your **gross** income is in. (*i.e. all income you have coming in, including benefits, before any tax is deducted*).
- It is just **your** income that is required, **not** your household income.
- If you need any **help** please ask any member of the **PCC**.
