Worship services will not be as we were used to, there are many Covid-19 rules to be followed by everyone

- Please do **NOT** come to church if you have **any Covid-19 symptoms** or if you have been in contact with anyone who has.
 - **Symptoms**: a new continuous cough / a high temperature / a loss of, or change in, your normal sense of taste or smell.
- Masks / Face Coverings MUST be worn at all times, please bring yours with you. No cover no entry - unless you are exempt – sorry.
- Follow the 1-way entry and exit system Enter via the main door (Market Street entrance);
 Exit via the side door (through the meeting room).
- Please use the hand sanitizer upon entering Church.
- Please complete a Track and Trace Consent form, 1 per household on your first return to church.
- Collection plates will be available at the entry and exit of the Church for your offering.
- Please maintain 2 metres social distancing between households.
- Only single use service sheets may be used and must be taken away with you.
- Singing is not allowed.
- We will not **share the peace with hugs or handshakes**, we will simply look at each other as we say peace be with you; Physical contact is not allowed.
- No kneeling at the altar rail. Communion will be administered in a single line by standing before the Priest, with social distancing between other communicants as they approach the Priest.
- Communion will only be given in one kind wafer. No wine from the Chalice.
- Communion will be given by the Priest on the palm of your hand only.
- The Priest will be wearing a mask and gloves at the time of communion for your safety and theirs.
- Toilet facilities will NOT be available
- No refreshments can be served after the service
- Please do not socially gather before or after the service in church
