Statement from Archdeacon David Sharples

At the request of the PCC the following written statement is provided for circulation to the congregation, members of the electoral roll and the wider parish community.

There has been some confusion about the current role and status of Rev. Sheila Cant. Sadly this has been amplified and distorted by some social media. At the beginning of 2020, Sheila felt that it was necessary to have a period of rest and recuperation and wrote to the Bishop of Manchester to withdraw from her ministry at St Lawrence's. **To be clear, Sheila has not been dismissed.** Sheila has now requested Permission to Officiate (PTO) from the Bishop of Manchester. This means that, as is the case with all other 'PTOs' she will be able to officiate anywhere in the Diocese of Manchester at the invitation of the incumbent or priest in charge (or sequestrators in a vacant parish). Where appropriate and with the consent of the incumbent Sheila will be able to exercise a pastoral ministry with individuals and in care homes etc as well as schools ministry. She would be designated as PTO not OLM or SSM.

There are undoubtedly significant challenges at St Lawrence's which has experienced a period of considerable turbulence. Strong views have been expressed about the reasons for the present difficulties. However, the current plight can only be addressed by acknowledging where we are and re-committing ourselves to working together.
